The top high school marksmen from across the state will take aim as they compete for the prized state title in the 20th Annual Civilian Marksmanship Program/HHSAA Air Riflery State Championships, Tuesday, Oct. 23, at Neal S. Blaisdell Center Exhibition Hall in Honolulu.

While there is some variation among the leagues on team size and selection processes to the state championship, all utilize the Sporter air rifle in three-position competition. Precision air rifles are not allowed.

Hawaii's Sporter air riflery state championship is the largest in the nation among high schools, and only one of two states in the U.S. that are sanctioned by the high school athletic governing body.

TOURNAMENT PROCEDURE, RULES AND SCORING

All 60 competitors in each gender fire in three positions: prone, standing and kneeling. Shooters fire 20 shots in each position at the target distance of 32 feet, 9.7 inches.

All competitors shoot at the same time, beginning with the prone position, followed by standing and kneeling. Twenty minutes are allowed for prone and kneeling shooting, and twenty-five minutes are allowed for standing shooting. There is a five-minute changeover period between positions and a five-minute sighting period between phases

A bulls-eye scores 10 points and each ring out from the center scores fewer points. The maximum points possible in individual competition are 600. Team scores are drawn from a team's four highest scorers.

RULE CHANGES FOR 2018

Beginning with the 2018 tournament, the challenge time has been reduced from 20 minutes to 10 minutes due to the quicker and more accurate Orion Scoring System.

A Finals round has been permanently adopted into the competition format after a two-year pilot. The top eight athletes in the individual 3x20 advance to the Final. Final round scores are added to the three-position score to determine the individual place winner. The final consists of 10 shots from the standing position, fired one shot at a time, with separate commands for each shot. The maximum possible points in the Finals is 100. Finals scores are not included in team scores.
